

Hey there.

Thank you for your purchase of the **Pull Up Backpack**.

This versatile and innovative backpack is designed to meet your travel and storage needs efficiently.

Please read through this manual carefully to learn how to use and maintain your backpack effectively.

Trolley mode.



1.1 Fully unzip the main zipper to open the large flap. Lift the flap towards the back of the case to access the 4 compressed compartments within.





1.2 Press the button on the telescopic handle and pull halfway until you see the pill-shaped tab. Turn the tab on the direction of the arrow.



1.3 Press the button on the handle fully up until you hear a click - this indicates that the trolley is already locked in position.

How to stow the trolley.

- **2.1** To stow the trolley, make sure there are no dangling straps that would impede the pull-up mechanism (e.g. the coat strap)
- **2.2** Turn the pill-shaped tab back into horizontal position, then click the button on the telescopic handle and pull down.

Suitcase mode & backpack mode



3.1 Open the small half-moon shaped zipper at the top rear of the case to reveal the top of the telescopic handle.

Press the rectangular button and pull up the two-stage handle until it locks at its maximum height.



3.2 Press the button on the telescopic handle to stow.

Unfasten the padded section to bring out the backpack straps.



3.3 Unzip the area on which the arrow is pointed to bring out the wheel cover.

Maintenance & Cleaning

Shell: The high-density water-resistant nylon shell can be easily cleaned with a clean damp cloth and a gentle detergent. Wipe away dirt and rinse with a clean cloth.

Wheels: Clean the wheels with a damp clean cloth to remove dirt.

Base: The base of the backpack is made of easy-to-clean high-quality plastic leatherette. Use a damp clean cloth for cleaning.

Side Pockets: Dust side pockets with a brush or wipe with a clean damp cloth.

Zippers: Clean YKK zippers using a small stiff brush, like a toothbrush.

Note: Avoid using strong bleaching detergents on any areas of the backpack.
