

9' Umbrella with LED Light Instructions

What is included:



STEP 1: Partially screw the 2 x Tightening knobs (G) into the side holes of the umbrella support tube(C).


STEP 2: Attach the umbrella support tube to the metal cross base (A &B) using the Washer (E) and Nut (D). Use the spanner to fully tighten, please do not over tighten.


STEP 3: Insert the umbrella frame (F) into the bottom pole (C) and rotate (G) clockwise rotation until it locks in place.


STEP 4: To open the umbrella, push the handle until it opens to desired width. Insert the pin to secure the umbrella.


STEP 5: To install the LED light, rotate (3) clockwise rotation until it locks in place. Open buckle on back of LED light (H), place around umbrella part (3) position and close buckle.

STEP 6: To operate LED light, use the switch and push it in ON position. <u>Before operating the lights</u>, <u>insert 4 x type LR6/AA batteries</u>










BATTERY (excluding):

- Battery compartment located at the back of LED light.
- Open battery cover.
- Place with LR6/AA battery.
- Correctly orient battery to polarity marks (+/-).
- Replace cover



Battery Caution and Disposal:

- For best results, use type LR6/AA batteries.
- Install only new batteries of the same type in your product.
- Failure to insert batteries in the correct polarity, as indicated in the battery compartment, may shorten the life of the batteries or cause batteries to leak.
- Do not mix old and new batteries.
- Do not mix Alkaline, Standard (Carbon-Zinc) or Rechargeable (Nickel Cadmium) or (Nickel Metal Hydride) batteries.
- Do not dispose of batteries in fire.
- Batteries should be recycled or disposed of as per state and local guidelines.

Care Instruction

- The fabrics in this product are developed to resist the effects of sunlight and outdoor use.
- It is recommended remove solar panel before putting it in bag.
- It is recommended that the umbrella is kept in cover in a covered dry place when not in use. Ensure umbrella is fully dry before storing. To clean fabric, brush off any loose dirt and lightly sponge clean.
- Never open the umbrella in windy conditions. When not in use, keep the umbrella closed.
- Keep away from hot surfaces such as grills and patio heaters.
- Always ensure umbrella is secured in a proper base and check for stability.
